

Mass Requirement

Confirmation candidates are required, as are all Catholics, to attend Mass on Sundays (or Saturday nights) and Holy Days. All Confirmation candidates need to attend Mass at least 80% of the time, and should attend St. Philip's vs. other parishes or college campuses (Millersville University). However, candidates may attend other Catholic churches, but they need to be present at St. Philip's at least 75% of the time. Candidates need to have the priest presiding at Mass--whether at St. Philip's or other parishes—sign a bulletin to show that they have attended Mass. Signed bulletins are to be put in the bin outside the Religious Education office each week.

This requirement of having bulletins signed to demonstrate Mass attendance begins for Confirmation candidates at the start of the academic year in which they will receive Confirmation, usually in mid-September.
